My great-grandfather was born in 1915 in the Tube village of the Namsky district.

Before being drafted to the front, he worked as an accountant on the Chikalov collective farm. In 1942 he was drafted into the army. He left his wife with three young children, including my grandfather Aleksey Vasilyevich Sleptsov.

He took sniper courses in the Irkutsk region. In the summer of 1942 they were sent to the front. From the letters of my great-grandfather, which he sent from the front, we know that he fought for the liberation of Stalingrad as a sniper. In the autumn of that year he died.
