My great-grandfather on my mother's side was born in 1922 in the village of Bordon. Having studied 7 classes in 1942 on July 20, he was called up for war. He was a red army soldier in the 597-th rifle regiment. After receiving a large shrapnel wound in his left leg in 1943, on August 7, he was taken to an evacuation hospital where it was decided to amputate the leg due to a large fracture. In 1944, on March 8, by the decision of the medical Commission, he was sent home.

A healthy man returned to his homeland after becoming a disabled person of the 2nd degree. After returning from the war, he married, had three children, left behind those who would glorify his name.

With 7 classes of training behind him, he worked as an accountant on a collective farm until his death.

My great-grandfather in the 1950s won prizes in draughts and was the first prize-winner in the district. He taught gifted children and some of them became Champions in the Republic or masters of sports of the USSR.

He died in 1961 on February 16, only 39 years old due to serious inflammation of the wound.
