

# Nikolaev Nikolay Alekseevich



(1921-2004)



My great-grandfather Nikolay was born in 1921.

In June 1941 he graduated from Pokrovskaya Secondary School .

In 1942 Nikolai Alekseevich graduated from the Yakutsk Pedagogical College. He began his pedagogical activity in 1942 in his native locality, the 2nd Zhemkon, as a teacher in elementary school.

In June 1943 he was drafted into the Soviet Army.

He served in the 6th equestrian depot of the Trans-Baikal Military District as a shooter. He took the military oath on October 15, 1943. He was awarded the rank of corporal.

In 1943 soldiers were taken from the military unit to the front, but the young soldiers were refused a request to send them to the front. He was in this part, Nikolaev was sent in 1943 to escort horses in the Crimean direction, in 1945 he accompanied military supplies to the Mongolian border.

The sergeant of the Soviet Army was discharged on December 25, 1945 and returned to teaching in his native village.
