

Belolyubsky Evsei Mikhailovich

My great-grandfather's name is Belolyubsky Evsei Mikhailovich. He was from Hangalassky ulus. He was called up for War when he was 26 years old in 1941. He fought on the Western Front. He participated in the liberation of the cities of Kharkov, Kerch, Sevastopol and Poland. He also participated in a bloody battle on the Dnieper River. My great-grandfather reached Berlin and participated in its assault. He was badly hurt there.

According to the his memories, he nearly died in one of the battles. Jumping over a barbed wire barrier, he caught his overcoat on and hung there for 2 days. The enemies, thinking that he was dead, did not notice him. Then our soldiers came and saved him. During the war he was wounded 5 times. But every time after recovery he went to the war. After long and hard battles, reaching Berlin, my great-grandfather returned to his native land in 1946. He was awarded the medals "For the victory over Germany in the Great Patriotic War" and "For Courage".
